Note 1:

heifers could be included, spring/autumn calvers should be recorded as a separate herd

Note 2 (New):

Needs to be calculated from mature cows only.
Do not include heifers

Note 3:

Average age of calf at weaning (date calf separated from the cow minus calf date of birth).

Note 4:

Average weight of calves at weaning. If multiple weights for individual calves are collected, the closest weight to when the calf is 200 days of age should be used
